Herbert H. Carnegie Future Aces Foundation Golf Tournament Makes a Successful Return, Raising \$20,000 for Youth Programming

Comeback event at Cherry Downs Golf Club brought together community, corporate and philanthropic supporters in the 70th anniversary year of the Future ACES Creed

September 17, 2026 - TORONTO, ON — The Herbert H. Carnegie Future Aces Foundation successfully relaunched its signature Golf Tournament on Tuesday, August 18, 2026, at Cherry Downs Golf Club in Pickering, ON, marking the event's return after a seven-year pause. More than 90 golfers, along with sponsors, donors and volunteers came together for a day of golf, networking and philanthropy, helping raise just over \$20,000 in support of scholarships and character education programming for youth across Ontario.

"After seven years away, this tournament made its return and it was everything we hoped for, thanks to our community," said Lianne Castelino, Board Chair of the Herbert H. Carnegie Future Aces Foundation. "Whether people teed off, sponsored a hole, volunteered or gave from the sidelines, they helped bring this tradition back to life in the spirit of Herbert H. Carnegie himself — a man who believed that with the right support, every young person could become a 'Future ACE' in their own life. This comeback would not have happened without the participants, donors and sponsors who stood behind it, and we are grateful to everyone who showed up for it."

The tournament's comeback carries added meaning this year, as the Foundation marks the 70th anniversary of the Future ACES Creed, the values-based framework developed by founder Herbert H. Carnegie in 1956. Since then, the Creed has reached more than one million students, inspired over 3,000 emerging leaders through conferences, and helped the Foundation award nearly \$900,000 in scholarships.

A decorated amateur golfer himself, with multiple Canadian and Ontario Senior Golf Championship titles to his name, Dr. Carnegie founded Future Aces Foundation in 1987 alongside his wife Audrey and daughter Bernice — making the golf course a fitting home for a tournament that keeps his legacy alive.

Proceeds from the tournament will support the Foundation's mission to foster self-esteem, ethical behaviour and leadership skills in young people, helping to expand access to scholarships, character education programming for Grades 4–12, leadership conferences and skill-building workshops and community-focused youth initiatives.
